## SOJOURNER LEGION OF HONOR MEDAL

#### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- (1) Active continuous membership in National Sojourners, Inc. for at least ten years.
- (2) Outstanding service.
- (3) Dedication to Masonic ideals and intense devotion to furthering all of the aims and Purposes of National Sojourners, Inc.
- (4) Proven qualities of leadership, tact, and resourcefulness in promoting and furthering teamwork in the activities of National Sojourners, Inc.

#### NOMINATED BY:

- (1) The National President
- (2) Any Past National President
- (3) Any Past National Commander

Nominations for the Sojourner Legion of Honor Medal may be made to the Honor Awards Committee by the National President, any Past National President, Past National Commander, or upon the written recommendation of any three chapters. Recommendations submitted must be accompanied by supporting documents, dated, and signed by the individual (NP, PNP, PNC) or the Chapter Secretary or President. Recommendations are submitted to the Honor Awards Committee via the National Secretary and delivered to the Chairman in a sealed envelope at the National Convention. c. An original and 4 copies (each placed in a separate sealed envelope and marked original or copy) of each nomination for the Legion of Honor shall be submitted in a single larger envelope, postmarked by U.S. Mail no later than 15 April, to National Headquarters and addressed as follows: Honor Awards Committee National Sojourners, Incorporated ATTN: National Secretary-Treasurer 7942R Cluny Court Springfield, VA 22153

**SUBMITTED TO:** National Headquarters.

**APPROVED BY:** Two thirds (2/3) favorable vote by the National Convention. To be presented at the National Convention.

## HOUGHTON MEMORIAL AWARD

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Superior accomplishment by a Chapter or individual toward advancing the purposes of National Sojourners, Inc. in any one year.

**NOMINATED BY:** Any National Officer or Sojourner Chapter.

**SUBMITTED TO:** Incentive and Awards Committee in writing and include complete justification. Chapters shall submit their recommendations through their Area and Regional Representatives.

**APPROVED BY:** National President on recommendation of the Incentive and Awards Committee. To be presented at the National Convention.

## MEMPHIS CUP AWARD

**QUALIFICATIONS**: An Area/Regional Representative having done the most to further development, growth, retention of membership and dynamic activities of the Chapters within their Area/Region.

**RECOMMENDED BY:** National President Elect.

**SUBMITTED TO:** Incentive and Awards Committee.

**APPROVED BY:** National President on recommendation of the Incentive and Awards Committee. To be presented at the National Convention.

## HORTON-TOURTILLOTT PLAQUE

**QUALIFICATIONS**: An individual judged to have done the most to further the Americanism Program of National Sojourners, Inc. for his chapter.

**RECOMMENDED BY:** Area and Regional Representatives.

**SUBMITTED TO:** Americanism Committee.

**APPROVED BY:** Americanism Committee. To be presented at the National Convention by the Americanism Committee Chairman.

## ANTHONY NATALI PLAQUE

**QUALIFICATIONS**: Outstanding participation in the presentation of ROTC Awards, in addition to participation in Americanism Programs by an individual or Chapter.

**RECOMMENDED BY:** Regional and Area Representatives.

SUBMITTED TO: Americanism Committee.

**APPROVED BY:** Americanism Committee. To be presented at the National Convention by the Americanism Committee Chairman.

## ODIE R. HOWELL, JR., BRIDGE OF LIGHT AWARD

**QUALIFICATIONS**: Significant contribution by Chapter(s) to the National Bridge of Light Program.

**RECOMMENDED BY:** Bridge of Light Committee after reviewing results of Chapter Bridge of Light Annual Reports.

SUBMITTED TO: Bridge of Light Committee.

**APPROVED BY:** The National Bridge of Light Committee based on grading of the Chapter Bridge of Light Annual Report evaluated on a score of 10. Chapters attaining a score totaling 18 or more for two consecutive years will be presented a National Award Flag Streamer which can be worn every year after the first award. To be presented at the National Convention.

## DALLAS L. KNOLL BULLETIN OF THE YEAR AWARD

**QUALIFICATIONS**: To recognize annually that individual who as editor of his Chapter's Bulletin/Newsletter published 6 issues during the 12-month period from January through December of the calendar year preceding the National Convention.

The following criteria will be used for judging Bulletins/Newsletters:

- (1) General Appearance
- (2) Composition, Writing, and Editing
- (3) Chapter/Camp News
- (4) Individual Sojourner News
- (5) Regional/Area News

- (6) National (Sojourner/Heroes) News
- (7) Masonic Community News
- (8) Reader Interest
- (9) Educational and Training Value
- (10) Historical Value

Each of the above criteria will be assigned a point value from zero to ten, for possible overall value of 100 points.

Area/ Regional Representatives and National Officers should encourage Chapter Editors to submit their Chapter's Bulletins/Newsletters to compete for this award.

**SUBMITTED TO:** Publications Review Board with five (5) copies of each issue of the Chapter's Bulletin/Newsletter published during the qualification period. They shall be clearly marked "For Bulletin of the Year Consideration", collated in complete year sets, and sent by the Chapter Secretary or Editor prior to 15 December of the year under consideration.

**APPROVED BY:** The National President based upon recipient recommendation by the Publications Review Board. The Board may also recommend up to three (3) Editors of outstanding Chapter Bulletins for Honorable Mention, one of whom may be the editor of the most improved bulletin. To be presented at the National Convention.

## THE NATIONAL SECRETARY/TREASURER WILL, UTILIZING CHAPTER REPORTS AND OTHER RELIABLE INFORMATION, DETERMINE THE RECIPIENT OF THE FOLLOWING AWARDS (TO BE PRESENTED AT THE NATIONAL CONVENTION):

## MELVIN W. BYERS MEMORIAL AWARD

To be awarded to Outstanding Chapter Secretary and will also designate First, Second, and Third Runners up.

## PAST NATIONAL PRESIDENT'S TROPHY (NUMERICAL GAIN)

For the Chapter having the largest actual gain in membership during the preceding year as computed by National Headquarters records as of 31 December proceeding, when compared to the corresponding date of the next preceding year.

## PAST NATIONAL PRESIDENT'S TROPHY (PERCENTAGE GAIN)

For the Chapter having the largest percentage gain in membership during the year computed as above.

## PAST NATIONAL COMMANDER'S TROPHY (HIGHEST GAIN IN ACTIVE DUTY)

For the Chapter showing the largest percentage gain in Active status Sojourners (members of the regular uniformed forces and Reserves on active duty or assigned to units of the Organized Reserves or National Guard) during the year computed as above.

## YOUTH EMPHASIS AWARD

The Chapter with the highest percentage of members under age forty as of 31 December, prior to the National Convention as determined by National Headquarters records.

## CHAPTER EXCELLENCE AWARD

PURPOSE: To establish procedures by which Chapters may earn the Chapter Excellence Award Certificate and streamer for their chapter flag and be eligible for Chapter of the Year Award.

The chapter secretary will complete and submit this application first to a Regional Reg if present by 1 April. If there is none, submit it for forwarding to National HQ to the Area Rep. If there is none, submit directly to National HQ. Always keep a copy. Contact National HQ by 1 May to ensure they have received your submission.

## CHAPTER OF THE YEAR AWARD

Selected from Chapters that receive the Chapter Excellence Award by the National Secretary.

**RECOMMENDED BY:** National Officers, National Committee Chairmen and Area Representative.

SUBMITTED TO: Incentive and Awards Committee.

APPROVED BY: National President on recommendation of the Incentive and Awards Committee.

## EXCEPTIONAL MERITORIOUS ACHIEVEMENT CERTIFICATE

**QUALIFICATIONS**: For Chapters/Sojourners whose exceptionally noteworthy performance contributed significantly to the accomplishment of the Purposes of the National Sojourners, Incorporated.

**RECOMMENDED BY:** National Officers, National Committee Chairmen, Area/Regional Representatives, and Chapter Presidents.

**SUBMITTED TO:** Incentive and Awards Committee.

**APPROVED BY:** National President on recommendation of the Incentive and Awards Committee.

## ADDITIONAL AWARDS (Chapter or local level)

#### Available for presentation at the Chapter or local level, or as otherwise appropriate

#### **CERTIFICATE OF APPRECIATION**

**QUALIFICATIONS**: Awarded to any individual, Chapter or group, whether directly associated with National Sojourners, Incorporated, in appreciation of significant contributions to the order.

SUBMITTED TO: Incentive and Awards Committee.

#### **50-YEAR SOJOURNER BAR**

The 50-Year Bar for attachment to the Sojourner Medal is authorized for members who have completed 50 years of Sojourner service as confirmed by National Headquarters.

#### **25-YEAR SOJOURNER BAR**

The 25-Year Bar for attachment to the Sojourner Medal is authorized for members who have completed 25 years of Sojourner service as confirmed by National Headquarters.

#### BRIDGE OF LIGHT CERTIFICATE

Available from the National Resale Activity for presentation to the Master of a Lodge or head of other Masonic Bodies to which presentation was made.

## HEROES OF '76 AWARDS

National Heroes Awards are contained in the Official Manual, Heroes of '76 for the four awards listed. It lists who can nominate or recommend, to whom awards are submitted and the decision process for the final National Commander's approval and presentation at the National Encampment.

## VAN DEVENTER TROPHY

**QUALIFICATIONS**: Shall be awarded to a Hero who has exhibited faithful and exceptionally meritorious service to the Heroes of '76 over the course of many years.

**RECOMMENDED BY:** Any of the National Heroes Progressive Line (Sentinel through Commander).

SUBMITTED TO: Van Deventer Awards Committee.

APPROVED BY: Van Deventer Awards Committee.

Members of the National Heroes Progressive Line, elected or appointed are not eligible for this award. The National Commander shall present the award at the National Encampment.

#### GENERAL JONATHAN WAINWRIGHT AWARD

**QUALIFICATIONS**: Presented annually to the most outstanding Heroes Camp for the year.

**RECOMMENDED BY:** National Heroes Progressive Line Officer, Past National Commander, or any Area Representative.

SUBMITTED TO: National Heroes Awards Committee.

**APPROVED BY:** National Heroes Awards Committee and approval of the National Commander. The National Commander shall present the award at the National Encampment.

#### THE NATIONAL COMMANDER'S PATRIOT OF '76 AWARD

This award is presented to those who have performed exceptional service to the National Heroes of '76 above and beyond the call of duty. Recommendations for this award shall be made to the National Adjutant via the Area Representative and may only be made by National Officers, Area and Regional Representatives, Sojourner Chapter Presidents, and Camp Commanders. The National Commander shall present the award at the National Encampment.

#### THE NATIONAL COMMANDER'S AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

This award shall be made to those, including ladies, who have performed excellent service to the Heroes of '76 during the year in which presented. Recommendations for this award shall be made to the National Adjutant via the Area Representative and may only be made by National Officers, Area and Regional Representatives, Sojourner Chapter Presidents, and Camp Commanders.

## ADDITIONAL AWARDS (Chapter or local level)

#### Available for presentation at the Chapter or local level or as otherwise appropriate

#### NATIONAL PATRIOT OF '76 CERTIFICATE
